- 1.1. Ottweiler: The flea market takes place from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- 1.2. Erlebnisort Reden: Saturdays: the flea market takes place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Sundays: the flea market takes place from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- 2. It is not permitted to dismantle or leave the market during market hours.
- 3. The stands are allocated by the market management
- 4. Children up to the age of 12 can sell their toys up to 2 m² free of charge. The sale until 14 years is only permitted in the presence of a legal guardian.
- 5. The statutory fire protection and accident prevention regulations must be observed.
- 6. The distribution of advertising without prior written permission is not permitted. the Organizer assumes no guarantee or liability for the content of the circulating brought advertising.
- 7. The organizer can cancel the event in the event of force majeure (a refund of the demurrage does not take place).
- 8. Driveways and entrances must also be kept free during assembly and dismantling.
- 9. The exhibitor is responsible for cleaning the stand area.
- 10. The organizer is not liable for theft and damage.
- 11. The organizer is only liable for personal injury and damage to property for which he is legally liable can be.
- 12. No liability for exhibits and equipment of the provider.
